Between the dates of 1-8/5/13 a warehouse at Unit 3 HARRISONS INDUSTRIAL ESTATE, HAYMERLE ROAD, SE15 was broken in to and items were stolen as well as property damaged and graffiti being drawn all over the walls causing £8000-£10000 worth of damage. The venue was used as an illegal rave and party goers have caused damage to an adjoining wall and stole property from a stocked warehouse next door belonging to the victim. A number of beds, trampolines, bar stools and gazebos were stolen fro the warehouse. Cordell has been forensically linked to the burglary and property that has been found at his home address from the venue. This has been seized and identified by the victim as coming from the warehouse. Cordell at first said to police that he brought both the chairs and the gazebos at a job lot and brought 5 of each. Cordell then changed his story and said he had brought the gazebo from FOCUS and that his mother has the receipts. Cordell then said to others on route to Walworth that he had done nothing wrong and helped someone through a hole in the wall, and that he had not committed any burglary. He then said "There aint been no burglary, there was a hole in the wall. You will have to arrest the whole of London. It can't be a burglary if you don't break in" "Police came 4-5 times and said we could stay. Check your records from a year ago. The place got done then and they left it in a state. It's the owners fault".
