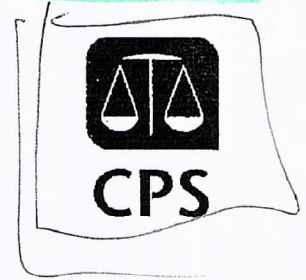

NOTICE OF SERVICE OF CASE AND WITNESS REQUIREMENTS

Notice of Service of the case

The copy statements [and depositions] that accompany this notice constitute the copies of the documents containing the evidence on which the current charge or charges are based.

These documents are served in accordance with Paragraph 1 of Schedule 3 of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 ("the 1998 Act") and the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 (Service of Prosecution Evidence) Regulations 2000.

You are reminded that by virtue of paragraph 5 of Schedule 8 of the 1998 Act, the bill of indictment in the Crown Court may include - either in substitution for or in addition to any count you are currently charged with - any counts founded on the evidence hereby served on you (being counts which can be lawfully joined in the same indictment).

Request for information concerning defence witness requirements

The written statements [and depositions] referred to above have been made by the witnesses named below. Application may be made to the court by the prosecution for each of these statements [and depositions] to be read out at the trial without oral evidence being given by the witness who has made the statement or deposition, unless I hear from you to the contrary.

If you want a witness to attend and give oral evidence, and to be cross-examined if necessary, you should inform the Crown Court and me in writing as soon as possible, and in any case, at least two

weeks before the date of the Plea and Directions Hearing set by the Court. This will enable the police to check on a witness' availability to attend court and avoid the costs and delay associated with any further adjournments for this purpose.

Failure to let me know which witnesses you wish to be called may result in the court allowing a witness' statement [or deposition] to be read, and therefore in your being unable to cross-examine that witness.

You should however be aware that the prosecutor may, at his or her discretion, require the attendance of a witness to give oral evidence, even if you have indicated that you do not wish that witness to attend to give oral evidence at the trial.

Request for additional information: pleas and admissions

Additionally, you are requested to inform me as soon as possible:

- whether you intend to admit all or some of the current charges. If so, which ones?
- whether you are prepared to make any admissions under Section 10 Criminal Justice Act 1967, which may avoid the attendance of witnesses. If so, please give details.

If you have a solicitor acting for you in this case, you should take immediate steps to bring this notice and statements [and depositions] to his or her attention as soon as possible.

Additional evidence

Other evidence, if any and if relevant, may be served in response to any notice served by virtue of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 (Dismissal of Charges Sent) Rules 1998, or under a notice of further evidence at a later stage.
