This statement refers to an incident that took place on Friday 6th, Saturday 7th and Sunday 8th of June 2014 when a RAVE took on "PROGRESS WAY ENFIELD."

I was on duty in plain clothes on the 21st Aug 2014 at approx 10.30 am conducting door to door enquiries on WOODGRANGE AVENUE, ENFIELD, when I spoke with a Resident⁽⁴⁾ who does not wish to be named who stated that she and her three young children Aged 9yrs, 6yrs and 8 months old, and that during the weekend were unable to get much sleep, and this caused stress to the whole family. The resident stated she had a wedding be organised at home that weekend, but was unable to do the brides which was planned to happen in there garden. This made them very angry and upset. She stated that the music was causing the windows to shake and this was frightening the children.
